SCHOOL BOOKING FORM

The Youth Mental Health Summit 2018 (YMHS) will include interactive presentations, workshops and activities. Teachers will also need to accompany the students who attend and it is each school's responsibility to comply with their own excursion procedures. **Each school is responsible for their own transportation to and from the venue**. At the event, students will be divided into groups and will rotate through interactive workshops, exhibitions and key note presentations.

At least one (or all if possible) of the teachers attending the YMHS is also required to attend the *"Post YMH Summit Professional Development Session"* on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2018. This is to ensure that your school is getting the most out of the YMHS and provides an opportunity to debrief and share feedback (successes and challenges) with other schools whilst also receiving engaging and practical professional development.

The YMHS is aimed at students in Years 8 -11 who are confident and have leadership capabilities to be able to promote positive mental health and wellbeing amongst their peers based on the information gained at the YMHS. If your school does not already have one, student leadership action teams to promote positive mental health and wellbeing can be established.

There is no charge to attend this event. Morning tea and lunch is provided. All participants will receive a show bag containing information and resources.

#### Terms & Conditions

- 1. All participants should arrive at the venue between 8:30am 8:45am to register and collect name tags and a resource bag before entering the theatre for the introduction and briefing session, which will promptly commence at 9:00am.
- 2. Please be advised, there will be no place to store school bags at the venue. Please make other arrangements prior to the event. Students should either leave their bags at school or on the bus (if possible), or bring minimal items as necessary. All participants will receive a show bag containing information and resources, including a pen and writing material.
- 3. Students will be allocated into 1 of 3 groups and will remain in those groups for the day, rotating between 3 workshops/activities. A detailed schedule will be sent by email to the contacts listed on the booking form closer to the event.
- 4. Morning Tea and lunch will be provided for Students and Teachers, Exhibitors and Volunteers. Vegetarian, gluten free and halal options will be available. Those with severe allergies or specific requirements (eg vegan, dairy, egg, nut or other allergies) are advised to bring their own food and drinks. It is each school's responsibility to manage any of their students' dietary requirements.
- 5. Each student and teacher will be required to complete a brief evaluation before leaving the summit.
- 6. At least one teacher attending the YMHS is required to attend a "Post YMH Summit Professional Development Session and debrief meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2018.
- 7. There is no charge to attend this event, except in the case of a 'no-show' as these places could have been allocated to another school on the wait list. Please contact SWC ASAP with any changes to your school's attendance to avoid charges.
- 8. If a school does not attend the YMHS or the Post YMHS Professional Development Training day for teachers without prior written notification to SWC (by email: ampha@swconnect.org.au) the school may be charged the full amount, \$110 per student and \$320 per teacher (the actual cost of hosting the YMHS).
