This course is for people seeking entry level training in the Electrotechnology industry. You will learn how to identify and use a range of components, accessories, materials, tools, equipment and technologies. Your course allows you do 2 weeks of workplacement.



Whilst on Workplacement You Can

- ✓ Use basic hand tools
- ✓ Electrical circuit testing
- ✓ Perform basic welding processes
- ✓ Do Sheet metal forming and assembly
- ✓ Practise cabling/wiring assemblies
- ✓ Produce electrical wiring diagrams
- ✓ Perform electrical calculations - voltage, resistance & amperage
- ✓ Assemble routine electrical & electronic components

Work Placements and School-based Apprenticeships & Traineeships are excellent opportunities for students to gain valuable experience in workplaces while still at school.
