What is the VET Summit?

It is a one day event, from 9:15am to 3:30pm where VET students in the region will meet and interact with employers throughout the day. This includes interactive Career Workshops, VET Industry Q&A Panel and Careers Speed Networking.

The VET Summit is held concurrently with the general public Apprenticeship and Traineeship Expo from 3-8pm.

Who should attend?

You should attend if your business or organisation represents a: Vocational Education & Training (VET) Industry (VET related employers), Registered Training Organisations (RTO), Tertiary Education Institutions, or VET focussed Not For Profits

How many employees can I bring?

You may bring up to 4 employees to the event. Please contact SWC if you wish to bring more people.

How can I be involved?

Your organisation can: Provide showbag resources, set up an interactive workshop, participate in the Q&A Panel / Careers Speed Networking, or set up an Exhibitors Stall at the Expo.

What will be my role for the day?

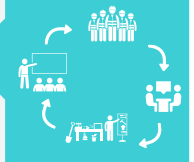
